Dear Keeneyville District 20 Families,

We are pleased to offer the opportunity for students ages 12-15 and their families to receive the COVID-19 vaccine through our partnership with the Lake Park High School feeder districts. This vaccine clinic will be held at Itasca Park District today, May 14 (2:00pm-7:45pm) and Friday, June 4 (2:00pm-7:45pm) and is open to all Keeneyville D20 families (age 12 and older). For more information visit <u>https://bit.ly/D20_COVID_Vaccine_Registration</u>. The vaccine is optional, but it is one of the mitigation strategies that can help to keep our community healthy. We will also continue to monitor COVID-19 metrics and implement the <u>Health and Safety Protocols</u> in our buildings to maintain a safe learning environment for our students and staff.

We have enjoyed seeing more kids and families outside with the warm spring weather. *Please note that school grounds should not be used during school hours.* This allows our students and staff to safely utilize school playground, fields, track, and other property for outdoor breaks throughout out the day. We also remind students who are dropping-off or picking-up their siblings at the elementary schools to arrive at the scheduled drop-off or pick-up time and maintain safe and respectful behavior while waiting for dismissal. The expectation is that all students and their families will not utilize school property, until at least 30 minutes before or after school.

- <u>Registration for the 2021-22 School Year</u> is now open for all grades. We strongly encourage that you register now to take advantage of the special discount of <u>no registration fee</u> through Monday, May 31. There is still a \$50 Technology Fee for all students. The Early Bird Special will not be extended. Starting June 1, the \$150 Registration Fee will be applied.

- <u>Food Service</u>: Starting next Monday, May 17, breakfast will be offered at school rather than being sent home at the end of the school day. Students who would like breakfast should arrive at 8:15am for Greenbrook and Waterbury and 7:30am for Spring Wood. Free lunch will continue to be offered to all students during the normal lunch period. Remote students can still pick-up meal packs at Greenbrook on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays between 9-10:30am. Please note the <u>special pick-up schedule</u> for Memorial Day weekend.
- <u>D20 Chromebooks + Hotspots</u>: All students must return their D20 chromebook for the summer as scheduled by your school, except for D20 Summer School students who should keep their devices through the last day of summer school classes. We also ask that families return their loaned hotspot devices by the end of the school year. Please send the hotspot to school with your child to avoid paying the replacement fee for the device.
