What Bears Eat

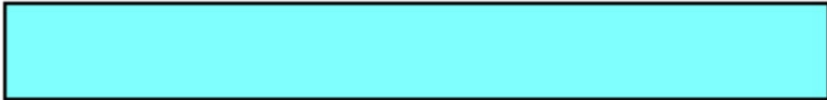
Many people think bears eat only meat, but they actually eat mostly vegetation. Bears eat wild berries, nuts, berries, and grass. They even love insects!
