Dear Waterbury School Community,

On Thursday, October 31, the Illinois State Board of Education will release the Illinois School Report Cards. Just as students bring home a report card, every school and district in the state receives one, too. Information about this year's report card can be found at:

The Illinois State Board of Education annually releases a School Report Card that shows how each school, district, and the state is performing on a wide range of educational goals. The School Report Card has two main components: the At-a-Glance Report Card that provides important information about each school or district in a one-page, printable format; and the Online ISBE Report Card that delivers in-depth information with explanations of each indicator online. The ISBE Report Card link is located under the school address.

After pulling up the web site listed above, you can type any school or district name into the text box in the center of the page under Find Your School. When you see a school or district's name you would like to view, click on the name or the search button, and it will take you to the school or district's snapshot page.

Once you are on the school or district's home page, you will see tabs below the School Snapshot, such as Academic Progress, School Environment and School Highlights. If you click on these tabs, you will see an additional list of topics. Click on these topics to show additional school and district information.

The data that you will see comes from the Illinois State Board of Education. The Illinois State Board of Education collects most of the data reported on the School Report Card from school districts through data systems such as the state's Student Information System throughout the school year.

The Illinois Report Card provides comprehensive information about every public school and district in the state. The School Snapshot page provides "Fast Facts" about schools, and a deeper dive into the facts and figures is available under the Academic Progress, School Environment, School Highlights tabs. For a summary of information about a school or district, you can view or print the At-a-Glance report by clicking the button in the upper right area of the School Snapshot or District Snapshot page.

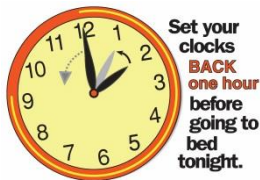
